During the morning all attendees will have the opportunity to hear recovery stories from consumers and families.

The afternoon sessions will feature practical workshops for attendees to network with their peers (i.e. clinicians, consumers, and family members will have separate workshops). Clinicians will discuss how they work in EIP programs using a recovery orientation.
